

Seduction - a slinky, stylish, silk scarflette

Materials:

3 skeins Berroco Seduce, colorway 4437 (300yds)

1 skein Berroco Seduce, colorway 4448 (100yds)

Crochet hook size F/3.75mm

scissors

tapestry needle



Ch 38

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook,* ch 1,sk 2 ch, in next ch dc 5 times, ch 1, sk 2 ch and sc in next ch. Repeat from "*" 5 times. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in sc. *ch 1, sk 2 dc and sc in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, 5 dc in next sc, ch1. Repeat from "*" 4 times. Sk 2 dc and sc in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc and 3 dc in next sc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch1, sc in first dc. * ch 1, sk 2 dc and 5 dc in next sc, ch1. Sk 2 dc and sc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from "*" 5 times. Turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 till yarn runs out or desired length, ending with row



Border is worked on 2 sides only - one width and one length.

Row 1: Join border color at the end of the last "Row 3" completed. Turn, ch 1 and work 1 sc in each sc and dc across to end. In last sc work 3 sc - this is your "corner 3". Work one sc in each sc and 2 sc in each ch 3 space down the length of the scarf.

Row 2: Turn, ch1 and sc in each sc back along the length of the scarf. Work 3 sc in the center sc of your "corner 3" and continue, working one sc in each sc along the width.

Row 3: Turn, ch1 and repeat Row 2 - remembering to work 3 sc in the center sc of your "corner 3"

Row 4: Ch4 - this counts as one "dc,ch 1". *Skip 1 sc, in next sc work one dc, ch 1. Repeat from "*" to "corner 3". In center sc of "corner 3" work "dc, ch 1" 3 times. Repeat from "*" to end . Fasten off and weave in ends.
